The DEEP BLUE project aims at developing skills and building capacities throughout enhancing geopolitical dialogue and international scientific cooperation (Science Diplomacy) in the Western Mediterranean Region.

Partners from Italy, Spain and Tunisia with the support of private and public local stakeholders, will strive to develop education and training paths aiming at creating an advanced shared knowledge and common methodological ground on the key sectors of Blue Economy in the Mediterranean basin while fostering North-South and South-South cooperation among public and private sectors.

Nationals from southern shore to northern shore countries: 6 months – 20 fellowships

The candidates coming from one of the northern Mediterranean country are requested to spend their traineeship in one of the countries of the southern Mediterranean and vice-versa.

Where: within the Euro-Mediterranean area. Priority is given to 5+5 Dialogue countries**.
